

THEODORE LEADERSHIP CLASS APPLICATION INFORMATION

What is it?

The Theodore leadership class is like a math or history class in the fact that students go to it every day for an entire block and gain a full semester credit for it. It is different than most courses, however, because students must apply to be in the class. Students must have a 2.5 GPA, a good discipline record, positive teacher evaluations, and be in 10th-12th grade for the 2019-2020 school year. Leadership students are expected to possess integrity, trustworthiness, a positive attitude, initiative, and school spirit.

All leadership courses are designed to equip students to serve as leaders in the school, community, and in every other aspect of their lives. Leadership 1 introduces students to the foundations of leadership and focuses on skills needed to grow individually as a leader. Leadership 2 builds on Leadership 1 by empowering students to lead a team or organization. Leadership 3 introduces to service issues and focuses on leadership qualities needed to succeed in life after high school.

What do students do?

- Study leadership principles like character, problem solving, communication, and teamwork through lectures, group discussions, and movies.
- Organize major school events like the annual spring Leadership Conference, Love Week, and Red Ribbon Week.
- Receive opportunities for achievements like the Chick-fil-A Leader Academy Scholar Program and President's Volunteer Service Award.
- Serve the community through projects like hurricane relief and by partnering with non-profit organizations like the A21 Campaign.
